Dear Business Owner,

In March, Palatine voters approved a referendum authorizing the Village to seek lower electricity rates for eligible residential and small business customers. After receiving prices and service qualifications from retail electric suppliers, the Village selected, **Integritys Energy Services, Inc.**, to supply electricity to the Village's Electric Aggregation Program. In addition to a substantial savings on electricity costs, the Village's new program will ensure that the fees we pay for electricity generation go to fund renewable energy sources, primarily wind, and most of it from Illinois sources.

As an eligible business customer, you will be automatically enrolled in the program unless you opt-out by May 17, 2012. There are no enrollment or switching fees and your new electricity rate will be 42.25% lower than the current ComEd rate.

No Rate Increase for Term of Contract

While ComEd's rates will continue to change each June and October, Integritys' rates are fixed and guaranteed for June 2012 through June 2013. Customers can expect to see savings on their electricity bills beginning in June 2012. Please see the enclosed Terms and Conditions for full details.

Billing / Service Delivery Unchanged

Other than the price and supplier, nothing regarding your electricity service will change. You will continue to receive one monthly bill from ComEd. ComEd will continue to deliver your electricity, restore power following an outage, and be responsible for maintaining the system that delivers power to your home.

Enrollment Information

After your enrollment is finalized, Integritys will send you a letter confirming your enrollment and welcoming you to the Village's Electric Aggregation Program. ComEd will also send you a letter confirming your selection of Integritys Energy Services, Inc. as your electric supplier. As required by
