# Village of Palatine Liquor License Information Grocery Store with Package Liquor Class B-1

# **Definition of a Class B-1 Liquor License:**

The retail sale of all alcoholic beverages in its original package, not for consumption on the premises where sold, in an establishment whose primary purpose is the sale of groceries, with the sale of alcoholic beverages as a subsidiary sale. The establishment must have a minimum of twenty thousand (20,000) square feet of floor area, with no more than ten percent (10%) of the floor area used for the display of alcoholic beverages and no more than ten percent (10%) of its gross income shall be derived from the sale of alcoholic beverages.

# **Permitted Hours of Operation:**

Sunday - Saturday 6:00 a.m. - 12 midnight

**Liquor License Fee:** \$3,271.00 (as of January 1, 2014)

All license fees are non-refundable and paid annually in advance on or before July 1st.

### Palatine Alcoholic Beverage Seller and Server Permit:

It shall be unlawful for any liquor license holder to employ any person that has not obtained a permit to sell or serve alcoholic beverages pursuant to their license requirement.

# Class B-1: Register Clerk and Managers:

Palatine Alcoholic Beverage Seller and Server Permit Requirements

- Proof of completion of State certified BASSET Program or equivalent approved program
- Pass a Police Department background check

### New Employees

- Must be registered with the Police Department within 72 hours after being employed by the establishment
- Must receive a Palatine Alcoholic Beverage Seller and Server Permit within 30 days from the beginning of their employment date

At all times when the premise is open and operational, at least one manager with an Alcoholic Beverage Seller and Server Permit must be on duty.

# **Dram Shop Insurance:**

Each liquor establishment must provide the Village a Certificate of Dram Shop insurance evidencing cover for the <u>full term</u> (July 1 - June 30) of the Palatine Liquor License, with a provision for 10 days prior notice of the Village should coverage be cancelled.

# **Liquor License Holder Requirements:**

- Must hold a valid Palatine Business License
- Must hold a valid Illinois Liquor License
- Must carry valid Dram Shop Insurance
- Must maintain a list of employees required to have a Palatine Alcoholic Beverage Seller and Servers Permit
- Must maintain a copy of the Palatine Alcoholic Beverage Seller and Servers Permit for each employee

# **Display Requirements:**

- The primary liquor display area shall be located in the designated area as indicated on the approved floor plan on file with the Liquor Commission. Any change to the primary liquor display area on the approved floor plan shall require Liquor Commission approval.
- In addition to the primary liquor display area, a holder of a Class B-1 license shall be permitted up to three (3) incidental display areas for beer and wine only subject to the Village Manager's review and approval and shall be indicated on a plan on file with the Liquor Commission.
- A point of sale control procedure/policy indicating the liquor license holder's procedures and policies to prevent persons under the age of twenty-one (21) from accessing and purchasing alcoholic beverages and to prevent the sale of alcoholic beverages outside the permitted hours of the granted liquor license shall be on file with the Liquor Commission.

# **Liquor Restriction and Violations:**

- It is unlawful for any person under the age of 21 years to sell, purchase, or obtain alcoholic liquor, unless permitted by law
- No public indecency
- Peddling of alcohol is prohibited
- Premises must be kept in clean and sanitary condition
- Premises must be in full view and lighted
- Sale or serving to an intoxicated person is prohibited
- Sale of alcoholic liquor from a drive-up window is prohibited
- Liquor License cannot be transferred to another individual or corporation
- Liquor License cannot be transferred to another location
