Drive Merry & Bright this Holiday Season

With the holiday season just around the corner, the Palatine Police Department has joined forces with the Illinois Department of Transportation for the "Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over" and "Drive High, Get a DUI" enforcement campaign to ensure that festive gatherings don't end in tragedy.

From Dec. 13 through Jan. 2, law enforcement agencies across Illinois will adopt a zero-tolerance policy for impaired driving to keep our roads safe.

The Palatine Police Department urges everyone to take the following simple steps to prevent impaired driving:



- Plan ahead: Designate a sober driver, use public transportation or arrange for a ride-sharing service.
- Report dangers: If you spot an impaired driver, pull over safely and contact 911.
- Be a hero: Stop a friend from driving impaired by taking their keys and helping them get home safely.
- Buckle up: It's your best defense against impaired drivers.

This campaign is made possible through federal highway safety funds from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration administered by IDOT.




Palatine Police Release Thanksgiving Enforcement Numbers

The Palatine Police Department conducted a traffic safety campaign from Nov. 22 to Dec. 2 aimed at reminding motorists to buckle up and drive sober. The "Click It or Ticket" and "Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over" mobilization was carried out by the Palatine Police Department in collaboration with state and local law enforcement agencies across Illinois to reduce fatalities.

During the campaign, Palatine Police reported the following enforcement outcomes:

- 44 speeding citations.
- 77 occupant restraint citations.
- 181 distracted driving citations.
- 77 other traffic citations.
- 13 traffic arrests.
- 9 criminal arrests.



Holiday Overnight Parking

The Village is suspending its Village-wide overnight parking restrictions during the holiday period from Thursday evening, December 19, 2024 through the morning of Thursday, January 2, 2025. You may park vehicles on the street overnight during this time.

This holiday parking suspension DOES NOT include commercial vehicles. The Village's Code of Ordinances defines commercial vehicles as "any motor vehicle used by or for a business or service which may or may not bear any sort of advertising for that business or service."



Holiday Light Recycling

The Village of Palatine, in partnership with the Solid Waste Agency of Northern Cook County (SWANCC) and Elgin Recycling, is pleased to offer a Holiday Light Recycling Program now until January 31, 2025.

Holiday string lights can be dropped off at the Palatine Village Hall, Village Services Counter (first floor), Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.


