Annual Winter Curbside Brush

The Public Works Department will conduct its annual winter curbside brush collection starting on Monday, February 3, 2025. Please have all loose brush set out at the curb by 7:00 AM on that day. Crews will make only one pass down each street. If brush amounts are excessive, it may take all week to finish the collection. Please follow these guidelines when preparing your branches:

- Brush must be 8 inches or less in diameter to accommodate the chipper.
- Firewood, tree stumps and root balls will not be accepted because of the potential to damage the chipper.
- Branches should be as long as possible with cut ends facing the street, without impeding traffic.
- Clean Christmas trees (without lights or decorations) will be accepted.

The collection may be delayed due to snow. An announcement will be made if the pickup needs to be rescheduled due to poor weather conditions.

Internet Purchase/Exchange Zone

Buying or selling something from a stranger online? The Palatine Police Department reminds citizens to use their "Internet Purchase Exchange Zone" in support of a safer venue for residents to exchange goods sold through online sites.

A large sign designates a well-lit area on the west side of the main police station parking lot that is under 24-hour video surveillance. This exchange zone provides a safer area to reduce the risk of criminal activity.

Have your meet up location be, by the sign, at the Palatine Police Headquarters front parking lot, 595 N. Hicks Road.

Keep Fire Hydrants Clear

Snowfall can make finding and accessing fire hydrants extremely difficult for firefighters, and during an emergency - every second counts!

The Palatine Fire Department is asking the community for your help. If there's a fire hydrant near your home, please consider clearing the snow around the fire hydrant.

When clearing a fire hydrant, snow should be removed about three (3) feet away from the hydrant in all directions, with a pathway cleared between the hydrant and the roadway. Please exercise caution when shoveling because of the potential for vehicle traffic nearby. Do not stand in the street when clearing the hydrant and be careful not to slip and fall out into the roadway.


