Avian Influenza (Bird Flu)

H5N1 avian influenza (bird flu) refers to the disease caused by infection with avian influenza Type A viruses. These viruses naturally spread among wild aquatic birds worldwide and can infect domestic poultry and other bird and animal species. Bird flu viruses do not normally infect humans. However, sporadic human infections with bird flu viruses have occurred.

Please note the Village of Palatine is not collecting, testing or reporting dead birds for avian influenza (bird flu).

For questions about wildlife and bird flu and dead bird reporting, contact the **Illinois Department of Natural Resources**. Members of the public are encouraged to report concentrations of **five or more** deceased birds found at one location to **IDNR District Wildlife Biologists**.

For questions about poultry and bird flu, contact the **Illinois Department of Agriculture**.

How should I dispose of a dead bird on my property? If an individual finds a dead bird and wants to dispose of it properly, use the following method:

1. Wear gloves made of rubber or latex (i.e., not cloth) or a plastic bag over your hands – or use a shovel, tongs, or other instrument to pick up the bird and place it in a plastic bag.

2. Make sure the beak or claws don't puncture the bag.
3. Seal the bag and then seal it inside a second plastic bag. Put the double-bagged bird with trash that will be picked up.
4. Wash your hands with soap and water immediately after disposing of the bird.

Household Battery Disposal

Simple Recycling

Palatine has a free textile recycling program that provides free year-round textile collection via a reservation system. Residents may request a pickup by visiting Simple Recycling's **website** or calling 866-835-5068.


