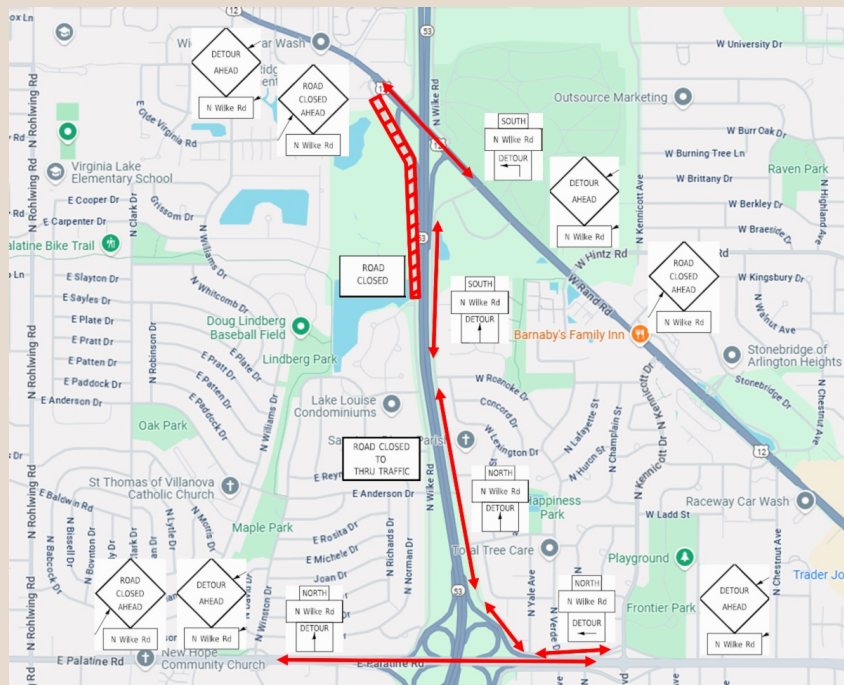

Road Closure Update: Wilke Road/West Frontage Road



As part of the Illinois Department of Transportation's (IDOT) Illinois Route 53 improvements, Wilke Road (also known as West Illinois Route 53 Frontage Road) has been closed to allow for storm sewer construction work on Route 53. The closure on Wilke Road/West Frontage Road from Claremont Drive to Victoria Drive has been extended to September 2, 2025. A detour route is posted directing traffic to use East Frontage Road from Palatine Road to Rand Road.

IDOT expects the work to be completed and West Frontage Road reopened to traffic on September 2, 2025, depending on weather.

Nearly 2 in 5 homeowners will put themselves, their families and their communities at risk by digging without knowing where underground utility lines are buried. Always contact JULIE to avoid causing costly damages to buried utilities, service interruptions and potential injury.

JULIE's agents are available to receive and process locate requests 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Call 811 or use E-Request, a free, self-service option to submit a request online.

Decorated scarecrows must be dropped off the morning of Saturday, September 20, at the Firefighters' Memorial (corner of Brockway and Slade Streets). The award ceremony will be held around 12:30 p.m. at the Oktoberfest stage. Scarecrows will remain on



display along the rail walk through early October for residents and visitors to enjoy.

Palatine Police Joins Statewide Labor Day Traffic Safety Effort



The Palatine Police is proud to be one of over 200 law enforcement agencies across Illinois participating in the statewide “Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over,” “Drive High Get a DUI” and “Click It or Ticket” campaigns this Labor Day. From Aug. 15 through the early morning hours of Sept. 2, officers will be out in force, focused on stopping impaired driving, enforcing seat belt laws and reducing other dangerous driving behaviors.

Officers will also be enforcing seat belt laws as part of the “Click It or Ticket” initiative. Buckling up is the most effective way to prevent serious injury or death in a crash. Everyone in the vehicle — front seat or back — should be properly buckled, every trip.

In addition to alcohol, officers will be on the lookout for drivers impaired by cannabis and other drugs. The Palatine Police Department will conduct a Roadside Safety Check in the 1200 block of W. Algonquin Rd from 10:00 PM on Friday, August 15, 2025 through 3:00 AM on Saturday, August 16, 2025.

This local effort is part of a larger statewide campaign supported by the Illinois Department of Transportation, which administers the “Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over” and “Click It or Ticket” campaigns with federal highway safety funds.
