Labor Day Refuse Collection One Day Later




All refuse collections for the Village of Palatine are scheduled for pick up one day later during the week of Labor Day.

Construction Alert: Wilke Road Resurfacing



The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) will be resurfacing Wilke Road (also known as West Illinois Route 53 Frontage Road) from Rand Road to Alison Drive. Work is scheduled to begin the week of September 2, 2025 and IDOT expects the job to be completed by the end of October. This project includes pavement resurfacing and base course patching, concrete curb removal and replacement, and sidewalk removal and replacement to meet ADA requirements.

Wilke Road will be accessible throughout the duration of the project, but at times access will be limited during working hours due to the construction activities.

Construction Update: Illinois Route 53 Improvements

As part of the Illinois Department of Transportation's (IDOT) Illinois Route 53 improvements, milling and resurfacing on Route 53 from south of Kirchoff Road to south of Rand Road began the week of August 25, 2025. At least two lanes in each direction will remain open during daytime hours. Overnight lane closures and intermittent ramp closures are to be expected.

Construction is anticipated to continue through mid-November and will be paused during winter.

Route 53 will be restored to three lanes in each direction during this time. Work will resume in spring 2026 and IDOT expects the project to be completed in 2027.

This project includes pavement reconstruction and resurfacing, ramp resurfacing, traffic signal modernization, lighting and drainage improvements, and bridge rehabilitation from Algonquin Road to Lake Cook Road.

"Feeding of Wildlife" Friendly Reminder

Many people think they are being kind by feeding wildlife, but it can cause issues in your neighborhood by bringing in unwanted wildlife and stray animals. Please do your part to keep wildlife and rodents away from your home.

Do not feed animals like feral cats, squirrels, deer or birds (unless using an elevated bird feeder). In fact, in Palatine it is illegal to feed wildlife except for the use of elevated bird feeders. Elevated bird feeders are allowed for use as long as all food, feed or seed is placed in a feeder designed for the specific purpose of feeding birds.
