The Village of Palatine contracted with Hammer Construction to perform maintenance repairs at the Gateway Center Parking Deck located at 251 West Colfax Street.

Effective this Monday, September 15, the west stair tower in the parking deck will be

temporarily closed for floor repairs for two weeks through September 26. Please use the east or north stair towers while the work in the west tower is being completed. The payment meters in the west tower have been moved to accommodate the work. The payment meters in the east stair tower and at the train station will be available during this time.

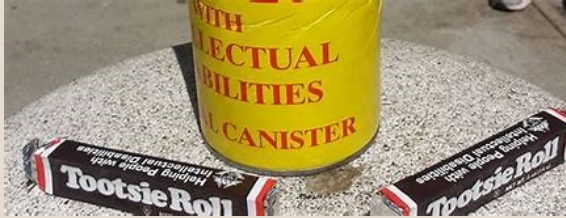

Lead Water Service Inventory



Lead service lines and lead components in internal plumbing are the most common sources of lead in drinking water. The vast majority of homes in the Village have copper service lines, which do not contain lead and cannot leach lead into the water supply. To check the material of your service line, view our **water service inventory** and lookup your address using the magnifying glass at the top right corner of the map. You can also check the material of your service line by conducting a scratch test. Find the instructions on our **website**.

Prescription Drug Take Back, Electronic Recycling & Paper Recycling

Prescription Drug Take Back

A free service for collecting unwanted medicine from Cook County residents by authorization of the Cook County Board of Commissioners.

- Collection is anonymous
- Bring unwanted/expired human and pet medication to ensure proper disposal- pills only
- Pills may be brought in prescription bottles, which will be shredded to destroy identity or in unmarked plastic bags
- Liquid medication and sharps will not be accepted

Electronic Recycling

Disposes of unwanted electronics. to protect the environment and to keep communities safe.

The following electronics accepted:

- Cables – all type
- Cell phones/Telephone Devices
- Computer/Laptops
- Hardware/motherboards
- Holiday lights
- Printers/fax machines/game systems/ monitors/calculators
- Televisions- Limit one per household/car
- Toasters/blenders/toner cartridges
- UPS batteries/car batteries

Paper Recycling

Cook County Sheriff's Office shred paper at it's secured facility and **do not shred on-site.**

The Cook County Sheriff's Office is NAID certified.

* Bring all paperwork in need of shredding and disposal. Remove all paper clips, binder clips, and rubber bands.
