Palatine Police Announce Additional Enforcement Results



The Palatine Police Department announced results of its additional enhanced traffic enforcement efforts as part of the Federal Fiscal Year 2025 Sustained Traffic Enforcement Program. These efforts, conducted between Oct. 1, 2024, and Sept. 30, 2025, were aimed at reducing traffic crashes and saving lives.

During the STEP enforcement period, officers issued **4193** citations and made **189** arrests. These results are in addition to normal patrol activity and include:

- **446 speeding citations.**
- **780 occupant restraint citations.**
- **2013 Distracted driving citations.**
- **11 DUI arrests.**
- **765 other traffic citations.**
- **109 traffic arrests.**
- **68 criminal arrests.**

These efforts were conducted under high-visibility traffic safety campaigns, including "Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over," "Click It or Ticket," and "Drive High, Get a DUI". By focusing on impaired driving, speeding, seat belt violations and other dangerous behaviors, our department worked to protect all road users and prevent crashes caused by risky driving.

The STEP grant was funded by federal highway safety funds administered by the Illinois Department of Transportation and is part of a statewide effort to improve roadway safety and reduce traffic-related fatalities.


District 1 and 2 Residents' Meeting October 15
