## Recycle Your Leftover Paint

SWANCC has a new, easy option to recycle paint with **PaintCare** at more than 250 drop-off sites across the state.

The **PaintCare** program is Illinois's new initiative that makes it easier to recycle or safely dispose of leftover latex and oil-based household paint. Funded through a small fee added to the purchase of new paint, the program sets up **FREE**, convenient drop-off sites where residents and businesses can bring unused paint instead of throwing it
